The Hemlock Girl Scout Council serves 15 counties in central Pennsylvania and operates four campsites. The newest, dubbed Camp Golden Pond, is situated on the southern slope of Tussey Mountain. The Schreyer Family Great Hall is the first major expenditure in the council's projected \$2.5 million camp improvement program. It provides a central dining facility with commercial-grade kitchen.

Ling Partnership provided design services for HVAC, plumbing and electrical systems, as well as assistance in acoustic analysis.

During the dedication ceremony for the building, the most-overheard comment from the general public was, "it looks like it's always been there". For a facility intended to preserve and enhance the rustic feel of the campsite as a whole, and of its neighboring buildings, no higher compliment could be paid.
