Neff Elementary School was the third in a series of Elementary Schools in the District to undergo renovation. Instead of the boiler and chiller systems, a Geothermal Heat Pump System was used to provide heating and cooling for the historic structure and additions.

Ling Partnership (formerly Parfitt/Ling) designed the first Geothermal System for a school building in Pennsylvania. The system had a lower construction cost and provided 15% savings in energy costs.

The project received an energy award from Gov. Tom Ridge and a citation from the Pennsylvania House of Representatives in 1997.
