Pine Hall Lutheran Church

This church on the country road into State College has served many generations of local families. When the congregation found the existing facility no longer adequate, they decided to move the brick building back from the highway and build an addition. The project retained the original brick building and bell tower. New foundation was built to support the relocated building farther back away from the heavily traveled College Avenue. A two-story addition was added in the rear of the building. The new facility offered new Sunday School rooms, a fellowship hall, a kitchen, office space and a gathering space.

Ling Partnership engineered the new mechanical and electrical systems to provide air conditioning for the entire facility. New lighting fixtures, identical in appearance to the existing fixtures, were installed in the sanctuary to provide an improved lighting level.

The facility was enlarged and upgraded for many more generations of State College worshippers to serve the Lord and the community.
